

**2018 NJAA SUMMER JAI-ALAI LEAGUE RULES:**

- 1. All games are played to 15 straight points. Each player shall play 5 games per week.**
  
- 2. The serving team has choice of ball (slow, medium, or fast). Only one serve shall be permitted at all times. Frontcourters shall stay in front of the "Julio" line until the ball bounces between the under & over lines.**
  
- 3. Bonus points are awarded for wins (3 pts), places (2 pts), and shows (1 pt).**
  
- 4. Playoffs will be played if, and when, necessary. If there is a three way, or greater tie, the playoff shall be performed as per professional jai-alai methods.**
  
- 5. Weekly points standings are based on total points earned, bonus points, and handicap points.**
  
- 6. If a player misses a weekly performance, their weekly points standings will consist of totaling their average points (minus 2 points), plus their handicap....per game. No bonus points shall be awarded.**
  
- 7. If your partner misses a performance, you must play solo. There are no substitutions.**
  
- 8. Handicaps will change weekly, based upon how the player performs the week before.**
  
- 9. Players may change positions within their respective team.**
  
- 10. The league will be extended an extra week for each rainout. Games finished prior to rainout shall be counted in league standings. Partial games shall be finished the following week. A total of 56 games shall be played prior to finalizing the league.**
  
- 11. A \$5 weekly fee shall be collected to pay for trophies and rewards.**

**12. There will be two league winners (front & backcourters), along with two 2nd & 3rd place finishers.**

**13. Players not participating in a game shall be designated to referee. All calls made by referee(s) are final. If two referees have conflicting calls, a replay of the point shall be performed immediately and without conflict, discussion, or argument.**

**14. If a player causes intentional physical or verbal abuse, that player may be asked to leave the game, performance, or league. NJAA representatives shall make the final decision.**

**15. All interference calls shall be made by referee(s). If a player stops play due to interference or concern, a replay shall be played without question. Safety is a top priority.**
